1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 06 (02 section each for Bal Vatika 1, 2 and 3 respectively). The total number of sections from classes I to XII shall be restricted to 28, of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for senior secondary classes. Further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation by law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq. ft. dimension. The number of students in each class shall be restricted to 40.
